BAPTISMS

Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

November 14, Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time: Dn 12:1-3 / Heb 10:11-14, 18 / Mk 13:24-32

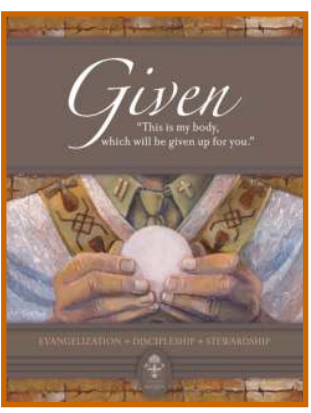

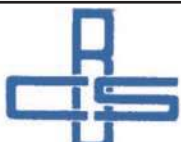
