November 28, First Sunday in Advent: Jer 33:14-16 / 1 Thes 3:12-4:2 / Lk 21:25-28, 34-36

Luke's Gospel says, "Beware that your hearts do not become drowsy from ... the anxieties of daily life...Be vigilant at all times and pray that you have the strength to escape the tribulations that are imminent..." Allow yourself to enter into the joy of the season, but don't lose sight of the reality of the season. Use these weeks to prepare your heart to meet your King!


Box of Joy *THANK YOU!*

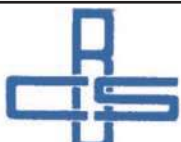
