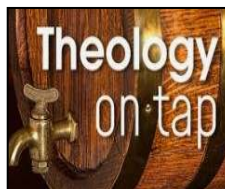
March for Life

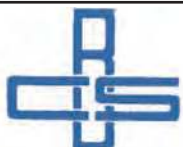
