**October 3, Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time: Gen 2:18-24 / Heb 2:9-11 / Mk 10:2-16**  
“Amen, I say to you, whoever does not accept the kingdom of God like a child will not enter it.” If you are reading this, it is very likely that you are not a child. Yet today’s Gospel tells us that our faith and discipleship must resemble that of children. So, what do we have to learn from the younger members of society? How can we model our discipleship off of their example? Children are humble and often shy away from prominence and publicity. Children are obedient by instinct; they have not yet learned the false sense of independence that often separates adults from God. Children know how to trust; they believe the best about others and do not suspect the world. Children know how to forgive, rather than holding grudges and nursing bitterness. Let us take a step back to watch how children approach Jesus and let us live our faith as authentically as they do!

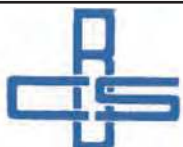
