August 2, 2020, Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time: *Is 55:1-3 / Rom 8:35, 37-39 / Mt 14:13-21*
At its core, Stewardship is an act of faith. We have to trust that our gift is pleasing to God, no matter how insignificant it might seem to us. In today's gospel, the disciples tell Jesus, "Five loaves and two fish are all we have here." Their use of the word ALL seems to come from despair. They do not believe that that amount of food will meet the needs of more than 2-3 men, and there are thousands to feed. But the use of the word ALL really is the key here. They had an insignificant amount of food to offer, but they offered ALL of it. Did Jesus work a miracle with the food, or with their unreservedness and complete generosity? Stewardship is so much more than what we share...it is HOW we share. When you share ALL of your heart with God and neighbor, the impact is beyond measure.

Additional Liturgical Ministers Needed

As you know, shortly before I arrived Roberta Lampe stepped down from playing organ for Masses. Additionally, two weeks ago Clara Seay stepped down from playing for Masses as well. I would ask that any of you who play piano would prayerfully consider the possibility of playing for our Masses. You do not have to be able to play the organ to do this. I will gladly assist you with getting prepared for doing this and working with the other two people still playing for us. If you are an accomplished piano player or if you are an organist, I would greatly appreciate you pondering this possibility. I would also ask that if you know of any piano teachers in the area that you forward their names and numbers to me as I would like to begin a mentoring program for students who are taking piano lessons that would encourage them to someday find their way into playing for church. This would be a long term project that would hopefully groom younger piano students to someday become church musicians.

Facilities Maintenance Committee

Currently we have several people that volunteer and offer their stewardship with various aspects of taking care of our campus. I would like to organize this group of stewards with a little more formality in order to communicate with various volunteers about smaller projects that need to be accomplished from time to time. I believe creating a "network", if you will, can provide reaching out to the right people at the right time to complete these various needs and projects. In addition to compiling a working list of those available and willing to help with these potential projects, I would like to set aside at least one or maybe two at most days a year that could become parish work days to accomplish some annual projects and upkeep that we could do as a parish. If you recently signed up on your stewardship time and talent form for any types of fix and repair/upkeep options, you will automatically be part of this list. Any others that would like to volunteer for any of these future projects can also sign up by calling the parish office and getting on the list. I think the greatest need will be getting a few people to be the lead contact persons I reach out to when a project comes up, and then getting the volunteers to schedule and tackle said project. In the next few days, I will put together a list of needed contact persons for various needs that volunteers can plug into such as fix and repair, tree and shrubbery maintenance, painting, simple plumbing, simple concrete, annual deep cleaning, etc. If you have any questions or would like to be a contact person, please call me as soon as you can at the office (316) 531-2252. 
